

NE Statewide EMS Conference 2026: Exhibitor Policies

1. Exhibit Space

- **Location:** [Younes Conference Center South](#).
- **Setup:** Each "unit" includes one or two tables and chairs as needed.
- **Assignment:** The Conference Planning Committee assigns all spaces and reserves the right to re-assign or alter layouts at any time.

2. Rules and Regulations

Exhibitors must agree to follow these terms, as well as any additional rules published by the Nebraska Statewide EMS Conference Corporation. All additional rules issued by the Corporation are considered part of this agreement and are legally binding.

3. Restrictions

The organizers reserve the right to cancel an exhibitor's contract at any time. Exhibitors may not sublet, share, or assign their space to another party. All signs and advertisements must feature only the name of the company that signed the contract. Advertising materials must be kept within your assigned booth space, and all sound must be kept at a volume that does not disturb others. Aisles and exit doors must remain clear at all times.

4. Hotel Rooms

The Conference Committee will hold a block of rooms for vendors. However, vendors are solely responsible for making their own reservations and paying for their rooms. The room block typically closes two weeks before the conference.

5. Ambulance & Vehicle Displays

- **Safety:** Engines may not be run while the building is occupied.
- **Fuel:** Vehicles are limited to 5 gallons of fuel. Fuel caps must be locked or taped.
- **Battery:** Battery cables must be disconnected during exhibit hours.
- **Floor Protection:** Vendors must provide mats (like carpet squares) for all wheels and under-vehicle areas to protect the floor.
- **Quantity:** Dealers are allowed one vehicle inside and one in a static display outside.
- **Licensing:** Dealers must obtain a Special Permit from the [Nebraska Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board](#) to display or sell vehicles. This permit must be submitted with registration and kept on-site.
- **Move-In:** Ambulances will be placed starting at noon on Thursday.

6. Abandonment of Facilities

If an exhibitor leaves their space vacant or fails to show up, the Corporation may terminate the agreement immediately, and the exhibitor will lose all rights to the space.

7. Alcohol Policy

Alcohol is not allowed on the exhibit floor unless specifically approved by the Nebraska Statewide EMS Conference Corporation.

8. Cancellation Policy

- **15+ Days Before Event:** Cancellations made in writing at least 15 days before the event will receive a 50% refund.
- **Less Than 15 Days Before Event:** No refunds will be issued for cancellations made within 15 days of the event.
- **Late Contracts:** No refunds will be given for contracts signed within 15 days of the conference.

9. Care of Building and Equipment

Exhibitors are responsible for any damage they cause to the walls, floors, or equipment. All decorations used in the booth must be flame-proof.
